

1. Assessment/WOTC Screening Integration Workflow



1.1. Integration Registration

- 1. To register a new integration with UKG Pro Recruiting, the Assessment/WOTC provider supplies necessary information:
 - If the provider is an Alliances partner, they provide the required information to their Ultimate Kronos Group (UKG) Alliances representative.
 - If the provider is not an Alliances partner, they provide the required information in the Assessment/WOTC Registration Questionnaire (see <u>Appendix A. Assessment/WOTC</u> <u>Provider Registration Questionnaire</u> on page 26) to the mutual customer that is looking to build the integration.

These are the details that are required in order to register a provider:

- 1. The provider's authentication mechanism. Required.
 - **Basic.** The provider assigns a unique username and password to the customer. UKG Pro Recruiting sends this username and password combination when making requests for assessments or WOTC screenings.
 - **Token.** The provider assigns a unique token to the customer. UKG Pro Recruiting sends this token when making requests for assessments or WOTC screenings.
- 2. The **URL** on the provider's site that responds to requests for assessments or WOTC screenings. Required. UKG Pro Recruiting uses this URL to request an assessment or WOTC screening link for an applicant. The URL must use the HTTPS protocol, and must be a static URL; variables in the URL are not supported.

- 3. Provider-assigned **Partner ID** for UKG Pro Recruiting. Optional. This is an optional identifier that the provider may assign to UKG Pro Recruiting. The Partner ID will be included in all UKG Pro Recruiting requests to the provider's API endpoints.
- 4. If the domain names in URLs that will be sent by the provider in assessment/worc screening updates (for example, the URL for assessment results, specified in assessment_results_url) are different from the domain name in the assessment/WOTC request URL (see 1.1.1.2 above), then you need to provide all alternative domain names so they can be added to the Allow list and provider API calls are not declined.
- 2. The UKG representative registers the integration with the customer's production environment, and supplies the following details to the provider:
 - **Integration ID**. The unique ID assigned by UKG to the provider. This ID will need to be included in assessment/WOTC screening update requests to UKG Pro Recruiting.
 - **Authentication details**. These details will be used by the provider to authenticate with UKG Pro Recruiting when posting <u>assessment/WOTC screening updates</u>:
 - Identity server host name
 - Client ID
 - Client secret
- 3. If you want to request a dedicated test environment for the integration:
 - For Alliances partners, the test environment will be created and supported by UKG Alliances.
 - For non-partner providers, the customer submits a Service Request (SR) to UKG. The SR will ensure the test environment is created, the provider is registered, and Client ID and Secret are issued for the test environment.

1.2. Identify Environment and Tenant

To identify the correct values for the {environment} and {tenant} placeholders in the API endpoint URLs, Recruiting customers can log in to Recruiting and examine the URL in the browser address bar.

The customer's {tenant} value follows the first slash after the domain name. See the table below.

For the {environment}, identify the domain of the customer's Recruiting URL, and use the corresponding value from the table below.

1.3. Integration Activation by Customer

- 1. Once the provider's integration is registered with UKG Pro Recruiting, it will become available to the customer in their UKG Pro Recruiting settings.
- 2. The customer will need to work with the provider to configure necessary account details before turning on their integration in Recruiting settings:
 - **Username/ password**. Required if the provider uses the Basic authentication method.
 - Token. Required if the provider uses the Token authentication method.
 - Assessment package codes and names (only for the assessment integration type).
- The customer will turn on their Assessment/WOTC screening provider integration in UKG Pro Recruiting settings and configure their company-level credentials and assessment packages, if applicable.

1.4. Assessment/WOTC Screening Process

- 1. A Recruiter adds an assessment package or a WOTC screening into an opportunity.
- 2. A Candidate submits their application for the opportunity.
- 3. UKG Pro Recruiting creates an assessment record for this application with a unique assessment ID and sets its status to *Generating*.
- 4. UKG Pro Recruiting makes a <u>POST assessment-link-request</u> to the provider's assessment_link_request_url. The request includes the customer's company-level credentials: username/password or token.
- 5. The provider authenticates the request, generates the assessment/WOTC screening link, and returns the link in the response.
- 6. UKG Pro Recruiting displays the assessment/WOTC link to the Candidate. When the Candidate clicks the link, they will be redirected to the provider's assessment/WOTC screening page in a new browser tab.
- 7. UKG Pro Recruiting will also email the assessment/WOTC screening link to the Candidate, and make it available it on their Presence > Applications page so it can be accessed later if needed.
- 8. If the assessment/WOTC screening link is not received in step 5, the system will retry 3 times. Recruiters will be able to manually initiate additional retries if all three automatic retries have failed.

1.5. Assessment Status Updates

- 1. The provider will post an authentication request to the UKG Pro Recruiting identity URL and include their client ID and secret.
- 2. UKG Pro Identity will respond with an oAuth token, which will expire in 60 minutes.
- 3. The provider will submit assessment updates by making the <u>PUT</u> <u>candidates/:id/assessments/:id</u> request to the <u>results_url</u> that was previously provided in the <u>POST assessment-link-request</u>. In order to let the system know which assessment record to update, the request must include:
 - The provider's assessment integration_id. This ID is assigned to the provider at the time of registration (see step 2 in the **Integration Registration** section above) and will be supplied in the POST assessment-link-request payload.
 - The assessment_id, candidate_id, and application_id that have been previously provided in the POST assessment-link-request for this assessment.

Note:

The PUT request will overwrite all the fields of the existing assessment record. For example, if an empty Score field is provided, it would override the previous Score value and set it to null. We anticipate PUT requests to include the complete assessment record with updated assessment/WOTC result fields, where applicable. The **GET candidates/:id/assessments/:id** request can be used to extract details of an existing assessment record.

4. Any following updates should be posted according to the process in step 1.

2. Authentication and Scopes

2.1. With Assessment Provider

Basic Authentication over HTTPS by providing the customer's user name/password or token.

2.2. With UKG Pro

UKG Pro Recruiting API uses the oAuth 2.0 authentication method.

To request an Assessment API access token, make a POST request to the identity server URL provided by Ultimate Kronos Group (UKG), with required parameters in the request body.

Include the authorization token in the header of your Assessment API calls, prepended with the "Bearer". The expiration time for the token, in seconds, will be provided in the response (it's currently set to expire in 3600 seconds or 1 hour).

Review the Recruiting and Onboarding API Authentication Guide in the UKG Community Library for details on required authentication information and lists of data centers.

- recruiting.domain.candidates.assessments.read
- recruiting.domain.candidates.assessments.update

3. POST Assessment Link

3.1. Request Parameters

In UKG Pro Recruiting, candidates can view the assessments that are available for them to take, and access each assessment using a link. To request a unique assessment link for the candidate, UKG Pro Recruiting posts this API call to the provider's **assessment_link_request_url**.

For more information about when this request will be sent for a new applicant, see <u>Appendix B. Enabling and Using an Assessment/WOTC Integration</u> on page 28.







View the List of Integrations

After the provider registers with UKG Pro Recruiting, UKG adds the provider to the list of available integrations. The name of the integration matches the name indicated during <u>registration</u>.

The type of integration determines where it appears: under **Settings > Integrations > Assessments**, or under **Settings > Integrations > Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Screening**.



Enable an Assessment Integration


After the integration has been added in UKG Pro Recruiting, customers can turn on the integration and configure its settings.

Recruiting administrators can configure the integration settings.

Setting Details

- 1. In **Settings > Integrations > Assessments**, select the name of an integration to display its settings page.
- 2. Set the **Enable Integration** switch to **On**.

The Account Information, Assessment Details, and Packages sections appear.



- 3. In the Account Information section, enter the information provided by the assessment provider.
 - If the provider specified the Basic authorization method during <u>registration</u>, enter the **Username** and **Password** provided by the provider.


- If the provider specified the Token authorization method during registration, enter the **Authentication Token** provided by the provider.
- 4. In the Assessment Details section, enter a **Display Name** and **Display Description** to display to the candidate.

The candidate sees the name and description in the list of assessments that they can take. These fields are optional, but you can use them to help applicants understand the purpose and scope of the assessment.

5. In the Packages section, add assessment packages and edit their details.

Assessment integrations require you to add at least one assessment package. A package is a bundle of related assessments, taken together on the provider site. Assessment results shown in UKG Pro Recruiting reflect the results of the whole assessment package.

- To add a new package, select Add Package.
- To edit a package, select its name.
- Enter the **Code** and **Name** as provided by the assessment provider. Enter an optional **Description** to help you identify the package. Select **Done**.



6. Select **Save** to save the assessment integration settings.

Enable a WOTC Screening Integration




The Account Information and WOTC Screening Details sections appear.



- 3. In the Account Information section, enter the information provided by the WOTC screening provider.
 - If the provider specified the Basic authorization method during <u>registration</u>, enter the **Username** and **Password** provided by the provider.
 - If the provider specified the Token authorization method during registration, enter the **Authentication Token** provided by the provider.
- 4. In the WOTC Screening Details section, enter a **Display Name** and **Display Description** to display to the candidate.
 - The candidate sees the name and description in the list of assessments that they can take. These fields are optional, but you can use them to help applicants understand the purpose of the screening.
- 5. Select **Save** to save the WOTC screening integration settings.


Include an Assessment or WOTC Screening in an Opportunity

The Screening tab of an Opportunity allows you to add assessments and WOTC screenings that will be presented to the candidates who apply for the job.



You can add assessments and WOTC screenings to an Opportunity that is already published. If you do this, candidates who have already applied for the Opportunity can find the assessment or screening in their Presence—but they might not think to look for it there. To help them find it, you can send the assessment or screening to the candidate manually.

To send the assessment or screening to a candidate, select **Request Assessment** on the Applicant List page of the Opportunity.




Assessment Presentation to Candidates

After an applicant submits their application, UKG Pro Recruiting presents an assessment or WOTC screening to the applicant if:

- The assessment or WOTC screening is currently included in the opportunity.
- The respective assessment or WOTC screening integration is currently enabled.
- The assessment package is currently active (not applicable to WOTC screenings).
- The candidate did not give a disqualifying answer to screening questions when applying.


On the "Thank You for Applying" Page


Assessments and screenings appear on the acknowledgement page after the candidate completes their application.



On the Candidate Presence

Candidates can also access their incomplete assessments and WOTC screenings by going to their **My Presence > Applications** page and clicking the **Complete Assessment(s)** button.






When the candidate has completed all their assessments and screenings for a specific job application, the button text changes to **View Assessments**. The candidate can use it to view the list of completed assessments but cannot take them again.


Assessment Notification Email

Every <u>eligible candidate</u> who submits their application receives an email with a link to the <u>Assessments</u> page, where they can access their assessments and WOTC screenings.



View Assessment Results

In UKG Pro Recruiting, you can see an applicant's assessment or WOTC screening results on the Applicant List page of the Opportunity. The Assessment Status column indicates whether the applicant has taken the assessment or screening, and their score if available.



The Assessments tab on the candidate's detail page provides more detail about the assessment or screening.
